1250-1600

Buff, pink or red surface, dark blue or grey core. Slightly sandy surface. Wheel thrown, kiln fired. Thin and fine fabric. Minimal decoration, sometimes green glaze. Made in Potterspurly, Northants. Mostly jars, bowls and jugs but wide variety of homewares made.
