

Staffordshire Slipware (409)

1640-1750

Found everywhere. Fine cream fabric with white slip and pale yellow lead glaze with dark brown lines which were sometimes brushed with a feather while wet. First real industrial pottery, transported via the canal system. Mostly plates and dishes but some mugs and bowls.
