

St Neots Ware (100)

850-1150

Very densely shelly so probably not kiln fired. Early fabric is dark with fine shell inclusions, later fabric pale brown/pink with larger shell inclusions. Fast wheel made. Jars or rimmed bowls. 10th century jars have rims less than 180mm, late 11-12th century jars have rims greater than 180mm.
