

## Mid-Late Iron Age

---

6<sup>th</sup>-1<sup>st</sup> century BC

Largely shell tempered. Soft, grey-brown fabric with large shell inclusions. Sometimes covered in vertical cut lines – then known as scored ware. Hand made into thick uneven forms. Hand made to start with but by the end of the Iron Age wheel made pottery was produced. Can have a different colour inside to outside.
